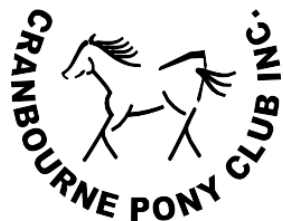
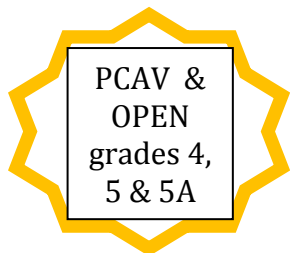

RUG AND BAG OF FEED FOR OVERALL WINNER IN EACH CT GRADE.

SADDLE CLOTH AND BAG OF FEED FOR OVERALL WINNERS OF EACH DRESSAGE GRADE.

SASHES TO SIXTH IN BOTH CT AND DRESSAGE.

Conditions of Entry: entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that current PCAV rules apply and acceptance of the following rules

- Neither the Organising Committee of this competition nor PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.

-PCA membership cards must be handed in when registering. No card, no ride.

-The following rule books apply: PCAV Handbook of ByLaws, 2017 Dressage Rules Jan 2017. PCAV Dressage Tests Jan 2013 & PCAV Horse Trials (Combined Tests) Rules Jan 2017.

-The Organising Committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.

-All refunds incur a \$10 admin fee. No refunds after closing date unless notified prior to ride time and a valid veterinary or medical certificate supplied within 7 days of notification.

-Dogs are prohibited without exception.

-Horses must be at least 4 years old. No stallions, colts or rigs allowed.

-NO LUNGEING PERMITTED.

-Times will be published on the CPC website prior to the event.

- All competitors entering the Open section - **including Pony Club Members** - MUST sign a **Public Liability Declaration** Form. Riders without adequate Insurance Liability Cover MUST ALSO complete the **Day Participant Waiver** and pay \$10 per day fee.. Participants who are NOT current members of PCAV, Equestrian Australia* (EA), an Inter State Pony Club, Arab Horse Society of Australia (AHS), Australian Endurance Riders Association (AERA) and cannot provide proof that they are covered by Public Liability Insurance Policy with a minimum of \$10,000,000.00 cover must pay \$10 participation fee.

- Open Riders must wear neat riding attire including complying boots & helmet

-Competitors may ride more than one horse subject to the conditions of *PCAV Handbook of By-Laws Multiple Horse Rule. (Rule 34.8). A horse may compete in 2 Combined Training competitions per day if ridden by one or more riders & no more than 4 Dressage tests*

-Medical armbands must be worn by all competitors

-Helmets must be PCAV compliant. Spot checks may occur.

-Gear check for each phase of the competition is required. (Penalty for not complying is elimination)

-The Organising Committee will pre-allocate and advise rider numbers. **Riders must supply their own bridle or saddle cloth number, to be displayed on both sides.**

-Queries, protests, horse abuse as per the *PCAV Handbook of By-Laws*.
