### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

PCAV membership cards must be handed in when registering. No card, no ride.

Correct “standards” numbered helmets must be worn as specified in current PCAV Gear Rules. Spot checks may occur, riders with incorrect helmets will be eliminated. ALL riders must wear medical armbands including Non-PCAV.

All Open riders need to read the ‘Day Participants’ section on the PCAV website regarding Participant Waivers, Public Liability Declaration and any fees due.

Proof of any current membership must be presented when registering on the day for Open otherwise the rider will be required to pay the \$10 fee on the day.

All participants in an Open Competition, including Pony Club Members, must hand in or sign on the day a Liability Declaration Form.

All Dressage tests taken from ‘PCAV Dressage Tests’, effective Feb 2013 – available from the PCAV website.

**NO Test calling** and presenting to judge as arenas are close together due to space restrictions.

Competitors may ride more than one horse subject to the conditions of PCAV Handbook of By-Laws Multiple Horse Rule 34.8.

The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide or combine any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.

Riders may use their own bridle and saddle cloth numbers so long as they are displayed on both sides of the horse. MPC will supply body numbers if needed.

Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.

Gear check is compulsory 20 minutes before first dressage test.

Queries, protests, horse abuse and doping rules as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws. Protest fee \$20.00

No stallions, colts or rigs. No horses or ponies under 4 years of age. **LUNGING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED**

No refunds will be made after closing date, except on presentation of medical or veterinary certificate provided within 7 days of the event. All refunds will incur a \$10.00 admin fee.
