THE COMPETITIONS AND MANNER OF JUDGING The following event is run under Table A and the specified Articles contained in the FEI rules

### **CLASS ONE - ARTICLE 273 COMPETITION OVER TWO ROUNDS**

273.1. This Competition comprises, with the same speed, two courses, identical or different, either in track or in number of obstacles or in the dimensions of the obstacles. Each Athlete must participate with the same Horse. Athletes, who have been eliminated or who have retired during the first round, may not take part in the second round and may not be placed.

Athletes will be placed according to the Penalties and time in the jump-off. The remaining Athletes will be placed according to aggregate Penalties over both rounds and the time incurred in the second round. Athletes not taking part in the second round are placed according to their penalties and time in the first round (if the first round is against the clock) or according to their Penalties in the first round (if the first round is not against the clock).

### **Class 2 - ARTICLE: 269 – ACCUMULATOR COMPETITION**

- 1) This Competition takes place over six, eight or ten obstacles with an increasing difficulty. Combination obstacles are not allowed. The increasing difficulty is not solely due to the height and spread of the obstacles, but also to the difficulty of the track.
- 2) Bonus points are awarded as follows: one point for obstacle number one not knocked down, two points for number two, three points for number three, etc. with a total of 21, 36 or 55 points. No point is awarded for an obstacle knocked down. Faults other than knock-downs are penalised as for Table A.
- 3) This Competition takes place with the first round against the clock without a jump-off.
- 4) For the last obstacle of the course, an alternative obstacle may be provided, of which one element may be designated the Joker. The Joker must be more difficult than the alternative obstacle and carry double points. If the Joker is knocked down, these points must be deducted from the total points obtained so far by the Athlete.

- Entry is conditional upon acceptance of these conditions:

- Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement and acceptance that the latest PCAV rules (2017) and the PCAV Handbook of By-laws rules apply. Both of these can be found on the PCAV website at [www.ponyclubvic.org.au](http://www.ponyclubvic.org.au)
- The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. An administration fee of \$10 will be deducted.
- Current PCAV, EA/EV, AHSA, AERA, HRCV, or SHCA Membership Cards must be presented to the Secretaries Office before riding. No Card, No Ride.
- OPEN RIDERS who do not have adequate Insurance Cover must complete the Day Participation Form and pay \$10.00. This form can be found in the PCAV website
- All Open Riders (including Pony Club riders riding in open) must fill in the 'Combined Liability and Waiver Form 2016/2017' the found on the PCAV website. [www.ponyclubvic.org.au](http://www.ponyclubvic.org.au) Those who do not have adequate insurance must pay the \$10.00 day insurance fee.
- All competitors need to complete the 'Tocumwal Dressage & Showjumping Jackpot Horse Trails 2017 Medical Response Authority' and 'Horse/Veterinary Authority' forms
- Competitor Numbers. The organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. Body numbers will be supplied and must be returned to clubrooms before leaving event. Competitors may use their own numbers.
- Open riders to ride the Dressage and Show Jumping in a jacket or their club uniform, and jodhpur colour for this event is as per PCAV uniform rules.
- Pony Club riders uniform as per PCAV rules for competition
- Combinations must enter in their assessed grade.
- Multiple Horse Participation Refer 34.8 in 'PCAV Handbook of By Laws 2017'
- Gear check is required for all riders, and before each discipline. Gear check is as per the PCAV rules.
- Medical armbands will be inspected at gear check to ensure compliance and is required by all riders.
- Correct 'standards' numbered helmet must be worn as specified in PCAV Gear Rules. Spot checks may occur and incorrect helmet will mean elimination.
- Lunging is not permitted at any time.
- Horses must be at least age four, no stallions, colts or rigs.
- Queries, protests, horse abuse and doping rules as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws.
- PCAV policies such and drinking and smoking will apply. Smoking policy applies
- Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property. Tocumwal Pony Club Inc. Registered Association: No Y02228-07.
- Camping will be available in designated areas at \$10.00 per night/per family and must be paid with entry form. NO Powered sites available.
- Yards are limited. Cost is \$10.00/yard each horse and must be booked and paid for with the entry form. Please ring Sam Arthur on 0428 831 891 and check availability before entering.
- The use of electrified tape, strings, ropes or chains, is not permitted at Pony Club Event. Electric tape can be used as a top line or as a "standoff" on a steel or solid yard, but not as a standalone yard. PLEASE - ALL YARDS MUST PACKED UP BY 7.30am (we have limited parking areas)

- All Competitors should have their own Ambulance cover (Open riders should also have their own personal accident cover)
- STRICTLY NO DOGS ALLOWED. Bringing a dog onto the grounds will result in elimination for the associated rider.
- Protests as per PCAV Handbook of By-laws 2017
- Medical Response Authority & Horse/Veterinary Authority (can be found on the PCAV website) needs to be filled out & sent with Entry Form, Stables & Camping.
