### Entry is conditional on acceptance of these conditions:

- The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
  - Grades may NOT run if insufficient entries.
  - Before riding:
    - PCV members must hand in current pony club cards for inspection.
    - Open competitors must demonstrate they are a current member of one of the following: Pony Club Association of Victoria;
      - Equestrian Australia\* (EA);
      - HRCAV
      - an Inter State Pony Club;
      - Arab Horse Society of Australia (AHSA);
      - Australian Endurance Riders Association (AERA); or
      - can provide proof that they are covered by Public Liability Insurance Policy with a minimum of \$10,000.000.00
- (If proof of membership isn't provided a Day Participant Waiver must be signed and an additional \$10 payment is required)
- No refunds after closing date except with a vet or medical certificate. An admin fee of \$10 may be deducted
  - Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
  - Medical Armbands must be worn by all competitors
  - Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the current PCV Handbook of By-Laws.
  - Dogs are prohibited without exception.
  - PCV Alcohol Policy applies. PCV Smoking policy applies.
  - A GEAR CHECK is required before riding in each test/phase of the competition. PCV gear rules Jan 2018.
  - HELMETS: Complying helmets must be worn, spot checks may be conducted
    - ASSA3838 standard
    - EN1384 standard, made in 2015 or older
    - EN1384 standard plus the VG1 standard
    - VG1 standard
    - ASTHF1163 standard
  - Due to scratchings, riders may be asked to ride at an earlier time than listed.
  - Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCV nor the landowners accepts any responsibility what so ever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
