All Dressage Arenas are on grass. Warm up Arenas are on gravel.

Jackpot is based on a matrix scoring system (info available on the day)
No equal placings – separation of equal scores as per PCAV Bylaws

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY: Entry is conditional upon acceptance of the following conditions:

1. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
2. Entry fee is \$57.00 for Pony Club sections and \$67.00 for Open sections. Please note there will be no refunds after closing date being Monday 26 March 2018 without valid medical/veterinary certificate supplied within 7 days of notification. \$20.00 admin fee applies for all refunds.
3. **Before Riding – ALL OPEN Competitors** must complete and submit a **Liability Declaration Form** (downloaded from Event Secretary or available on the day). A \$10 **Participation Fee** is also payable in addition to the entry fee UNLESS proof of current financial membership of PCAV, EV/EA, AHS, AHSA, AERA, HRC AV, an interstate Pony Club or can provide proof of Personal Liability Cover of at least \$10,000,000. If you are required to pay the \$10 **Day Participation Fee**, you must also complete and submit a **Day Participation Waiver** form (at the bottom of the Liability Declaration form).
4. **Before Riding – All PCAV Competitors** must present their 2016/17 and 2017/18 Grading Cards to the office for inspection.
5. **Gear Check for ALL Competitors** is required 20 minutes before their first dressage test.
6. Gear check will be using “**Pure Dressage**” Gear check Rules.
7. **Medical Armbands** must be worn by all competitors.
8. **All competitors** must wear “**Standards Approved**” **complying Helmets**. Complying Helmets are: AS/NZS 3838 (AU). ASTM F1163 (USA), PAS105 (UK), VGI (EUROPE), only up to and incl. 2015 (if made in 2016 not acceptable unless also complies with VGI). **Spot Checks of helmets** will occur and **incorrect helmets will incur elimination**.
9. All Dressage tests taken from ‘PCAV Dressage Tests’, effective Feb 2013 – available from the PCAV website
10. **NO Test calling** and presenting to judge as arenas are close together due to space restrictions.
11. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide or combine any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
12. All Pony Club Competitors must be graded by their DC for the dressage grade they have entered.
13. Competitors may ride more than one horse subject to the conditions of PCAV Handbook of By-Laws Multiple Horse Rule 34.8.
14. A horse or pony, if ridden by one or more riders, may compete in NO more than 4 dressage tests.
15. **Competitor’s numbers** – the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers and supply body numbers which must be worn when riding dressage tests.
16. Queries, protests, horse abuse and doping rules as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws.
17. No stallions, colts or rigs. No horses or ponies under 4 years of age. **LUNGING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.**
18. Drummies Bridge Reserve is Council Property ~ **DOGS ARE PROHIBITED WITHOUT EXCEPTION.**
19. Times will be emailed to all competitors Thursday night prior to the event and will be available on the Event Secretary website.
20. Neither the organising committee of this competition, nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
